

Tryout Expectations:

- 1) Attend all evaluations
- 2) Arrive 30 minutes early to size for uniforms and receive evaluation number
- 3) Return evaluation jerseys after each session.
- 4) Every effort will be made to place players in the appropriate division, however, effort, coachability and attitude go a long way to help determine placement.
- 5) If player cannot attend all evaluations, they may be placed in a lower division level.
- 6) Player must inform organizers if they will not be available for playoffs and Provincials
- 7) Players evaluation scores determine the first 75% of players to fill team. The remaining 25% of team is filled by coach from an available pool determined by zone.

Coaches Expectations:

- 1) Coaches will dress in team identifiable outfits
- 2) No shorts or sandals will be allowed
- 3) Coaches will need to acquire appropriate coaching qualifications as determined by Provincial guidelines (attach guidelines)
- 4) Coaches will communicate team/player/parent expectations, team expenses, tournaments, Provincials, etc to all parents and players at a team meeting as soon as possible.
- 5) Coaches will need to seek out two managers to open team bank accounts. Managers cannot be coach's spouse.
- 6) Coaches will communicate with both player and parent in a respectful and professional manner.
- 7) Fair play is to be considered at all times. Remember, we are developing life-long athletes and life skills, not major league professional athletes.
- 8) Coaches will engage in positive, efficient practices. If a coach needs help in developing these types of practices, they are to contact their zone coordinator.
- 9) If a coach needs help with develop game strategy, effective practices, help with parents or other coaches, please contact zone coordinator.

\Parent Expectation

- 1) Volunteer your time to the coaching staff.
- 2) Support coaches, players, umpires and opponents in a positive manner as they are all working to do their best.
- 3) Coaches have zone support to organize their team as they see fit, within the guidelines of fair, but not necessarily equal, play. Please be understanding.
- 4) If you have a concern, please address the coaching staff directly, in a calm and professional manner, before or after a game or practice.
- 5) If you are not satisfied with the meeting, please don't hesitate to contact a zone representative for assistance.
- 6) Enjoy the game.
